

Conditions of participation for a diving trip on board the safari ship AMBA Dive Maldives, operated by the company AMBA Dive private limited, based in the Maldives.

1.

The Liveaboard guest must present proof of diving certification to dive up to 30 meters and a diving certification to dive with oxygen enriched air on the first day of the cruise.

2.

The maximum permitted diving depth is 30 meters. The maximum diving time is 60 minutes. Decompression dives and deep stops are not permitted.

3.

The guest undertakes to dive in the so-called buddy system. The dive guide is not responsible for the diving activities of the dive guest. Diving without a guide is prohibited by law

4.

The Liveaboard reserves the right to change and/or cancel diving arrangements for, but not limited to, the following reasons. No refund or compensation will be given for changes or cancellations resulting from such events:

- The remoteness or inaccessibility of a diving destination
- Weather conditions in which the captain of the ship prohibits further sailing.
- Technical difficulties that cause the trip to become unsafe, dangerous and/or impracticable.

5.

The guest agrees to purchase travel insurance that applies to all activities that are carried out. The Liveaboard operators are not liable for any financial or personal loss or injury if the guest chooses not to take out such insurance.

6.

The Liveaboard operators are assuming no liability for any loss or damage to luggage or diving equipment on board the boat or during transfer to or from the boat.

7.

The number of dives is an estimate based on normal diving circumstances and is not a guarantee. There is no entitlement to a price reduction if dives are canceled or not undertaken by the guest. It is expressly pointed out that only one dive is offered on the day of arrival and one day before departure. Two to three dives are usually offered in one day. One night dive per trip is included in the maximum 3 dives per day. There are no air fillings. Diving can only be done with oxygen-enriched air, and the diver must be certified for this.

8.

If the Guest acts negligently or irresponsibly and causes damage or loss to the Ship Operator's property and equipment, the Guest shall compensate the Liveaboard operators at the current replacement price of any loss or damage.

9.

The guest agrees to be physically, emotionally and mentally prepared and able to participate in the activities for which they have registered. Any resulting injury or discomfort due to incapacity shall not constitute grounds for complaint or refund.

10.

The Liveaboard operators may prohibit the participation of any person on one or more dives where the diver is physically, mentally or emotionally unfit to dive, or demonstrates a clear lack of respect for applicable rules and regulations to deal with or cause harm to marine life, between Consumes alcohol during dives or fails to adhere to general international standards and practices for safe diving.

11.

The diving guest undertakes to use complete and maintained equipment for every dive. This equipment must contain the following items: buoyancy compensator, mask, snorkel, wetsuit with positive buoyancy and sufficient protection against the cold, fins, regulator set consisting of first stage, two second stages, pressure gauge, diving knife, diving lamp, surface buoy, signal whistle, diving computer and a diving compass.

12.

The guest undertakes to inform himself about the valid prices for extras and all other rules and offers on the Liveaboard operator's website, www.amba-malediven.com. Only these prices are valid.

13.

If an emergency evacuation is required and the boat must return to land, the safari operator accepts no financial responsibility for any resulting changes to itineraries.

14.

Nothing contained in this Agreement shall confer any rights, express or implied, on any third party.

15.

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Maldives. If any questions or problems arise from the Agreement or any of its provisions, the same shall be decided only in the courts of the country of the Maldives, excluding other courts.

16.

The failure of a party to enforce any provision or provisions of this Agreement due to the illegality, invalidity or unenforceability of such provision(s) shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision in the Agreement.

18.

The failure of either party to perform one or more of its obligations under this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of contractual performance of any other obligations in the Agreement.

I am aware that these declarations release the diving instructors, diving guides, the ship operator and their representatives and employees from any liability for damages of any kind, including financial losses, which may be caused to me, my family, my legal successors Participation in this diving trip and/or this diving course can take place.

I have fully informed myself about the contents of the conditions of participation, the exclusion of liability and the declaration of risk assumption by reading everything carefully before accepting the declaration as binding for myself and also for my family, and legal successors.

These conditions of participation were accepted by me via online check-in on the ship operator's website www.amba-malediven.com and the conditions of participation will be signed by hand on the check-in day.
